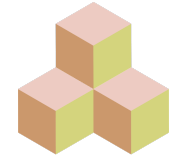


May, Might or Could



Study English Grammar

Learn English Naturally

Subject + may / might / could + present form verb

Subject + may / might / could + adjective

We use this to talk about an event in the future.

May

→ 70% certain to happen

I may read a book.

She may go to a museum.

Might

→ 60% certain to happen

I might see a film.

It might be sunny.

Could

→ 60% certain to happen

I could go.

The weather could rain.

'Might' or 'Could'?

Might = two options

I might go to the cinema. 

Could = many options

I could go to the cinema.
