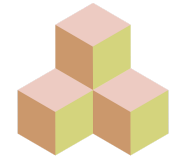

How to order in a restaurant

Can + subject + have + noun phrase + please?

May + subject + have + noun phrase + please?

Subject + would + like + noun phrase + please?

Examples

Can I have the fish please?

May we have two cups of tea please?

I would like a slice of cake please?

Can my daughter have a cheese pizza please?

May I have the steak and ice cream please?

I would like two glasses of water and two beers please?

Determiners with food

Rule 1

More than one noun = a

Rule 2

One noun = the

Rule 3

Use a number (two slices) or uncountable quantity (a lot of, some, a little)

Rule 4

Use a countable form (glass of..., pint of..., bowl of...)
