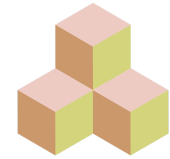

Subject + would + present form verb + noun / noun phrase

Subject'd + present form verb + noun / noun phrase

Used for a hypothetical future event.

Positive

I would watch it.

They'd visit the south of France.

Negative

I would not go.

We wouldn't return there.

Questions

Would you read that book?

Would she like to go?

I would...but...

I would watch a film with you but I'm busy.

= The subject would do the action but can't for some reason.

I wouldn't...because...

I wouldn't watch that film because it's not very good.

= The subject would not do the action and we use 'because' to explain why.
